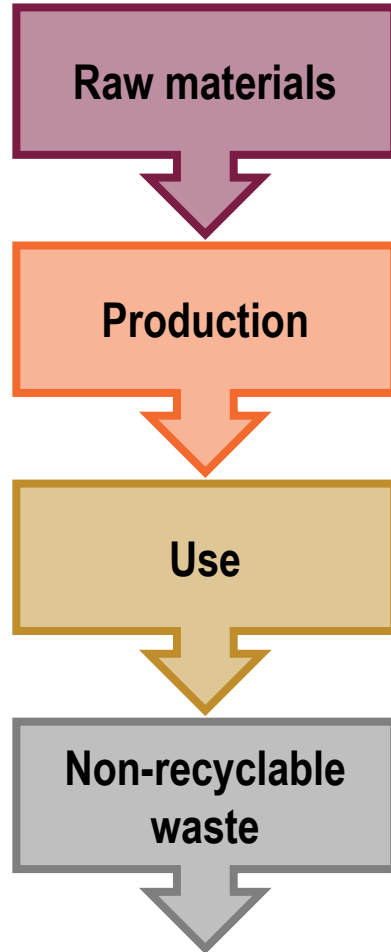

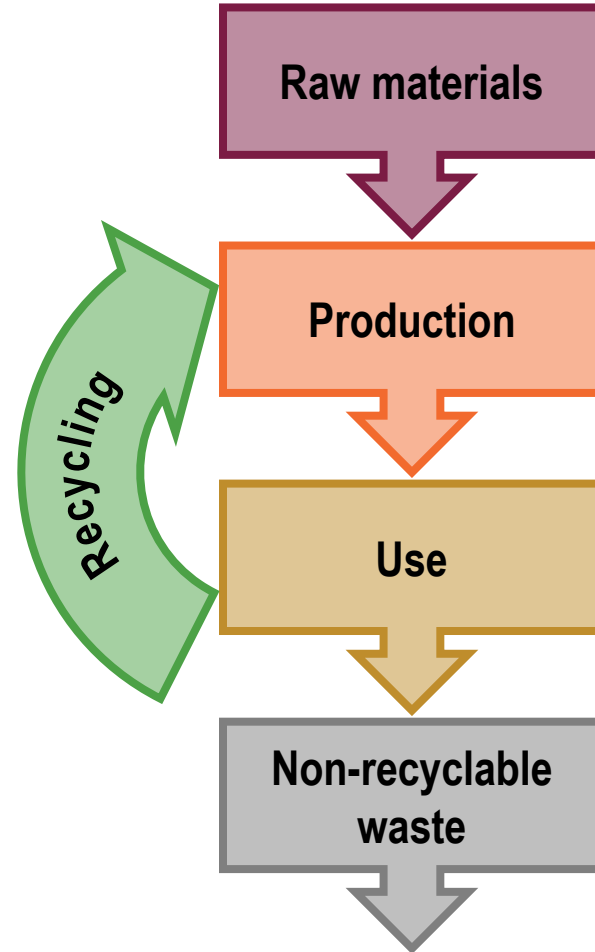

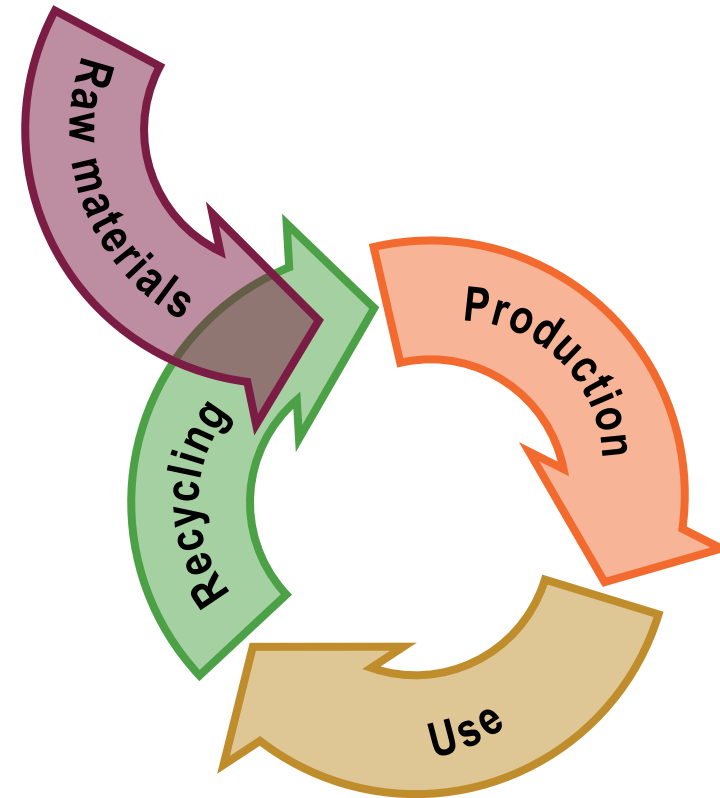
Linear economy

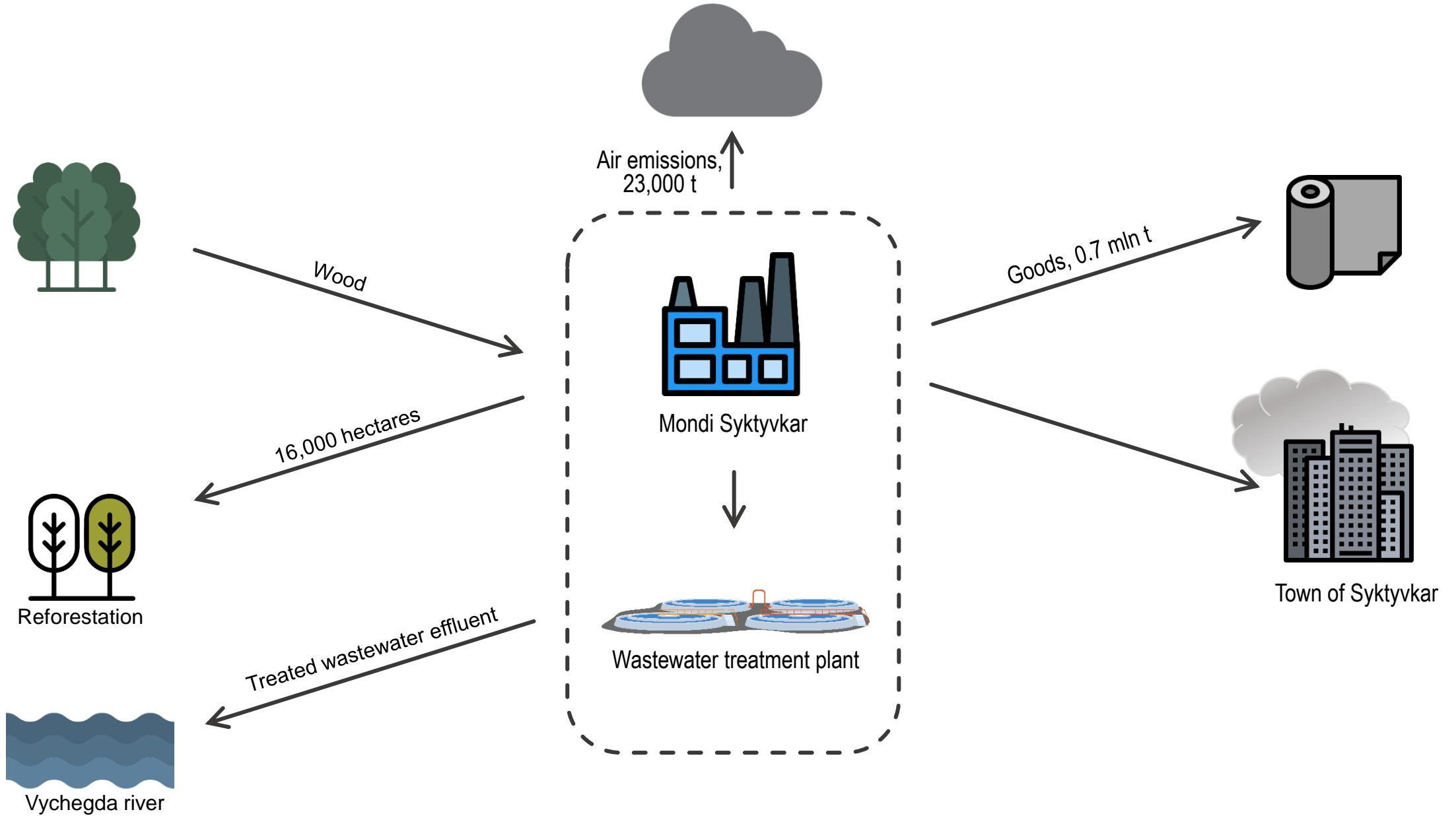

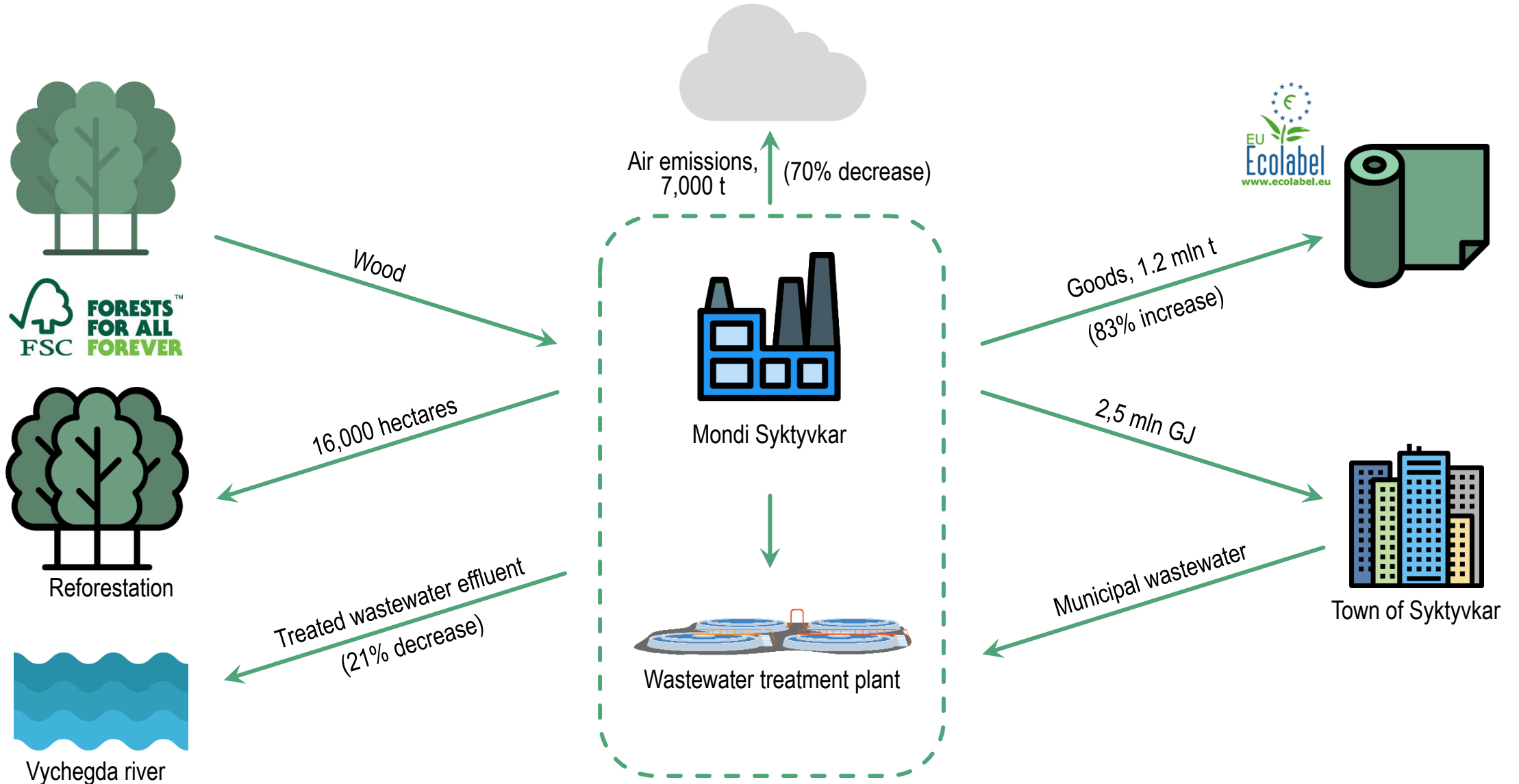

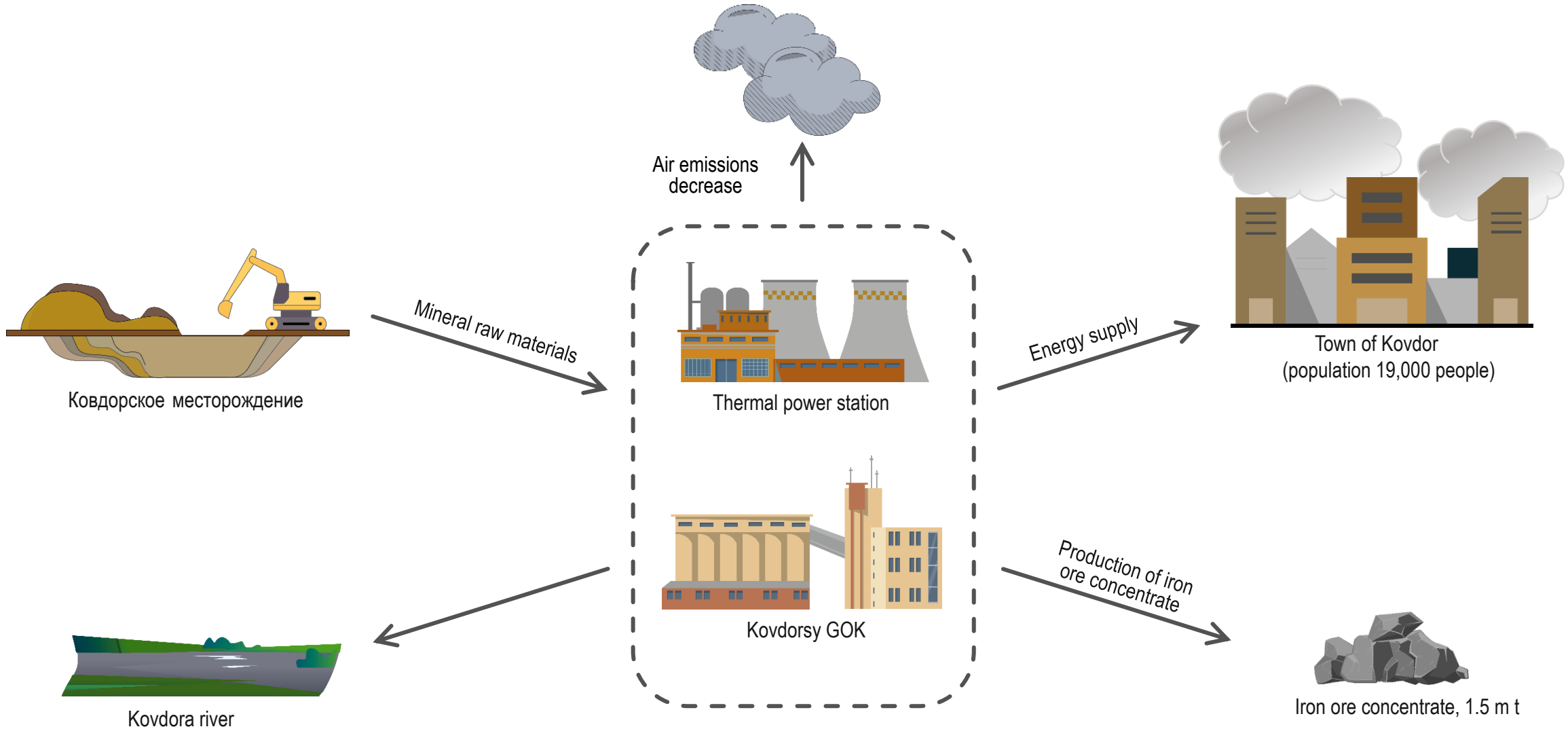

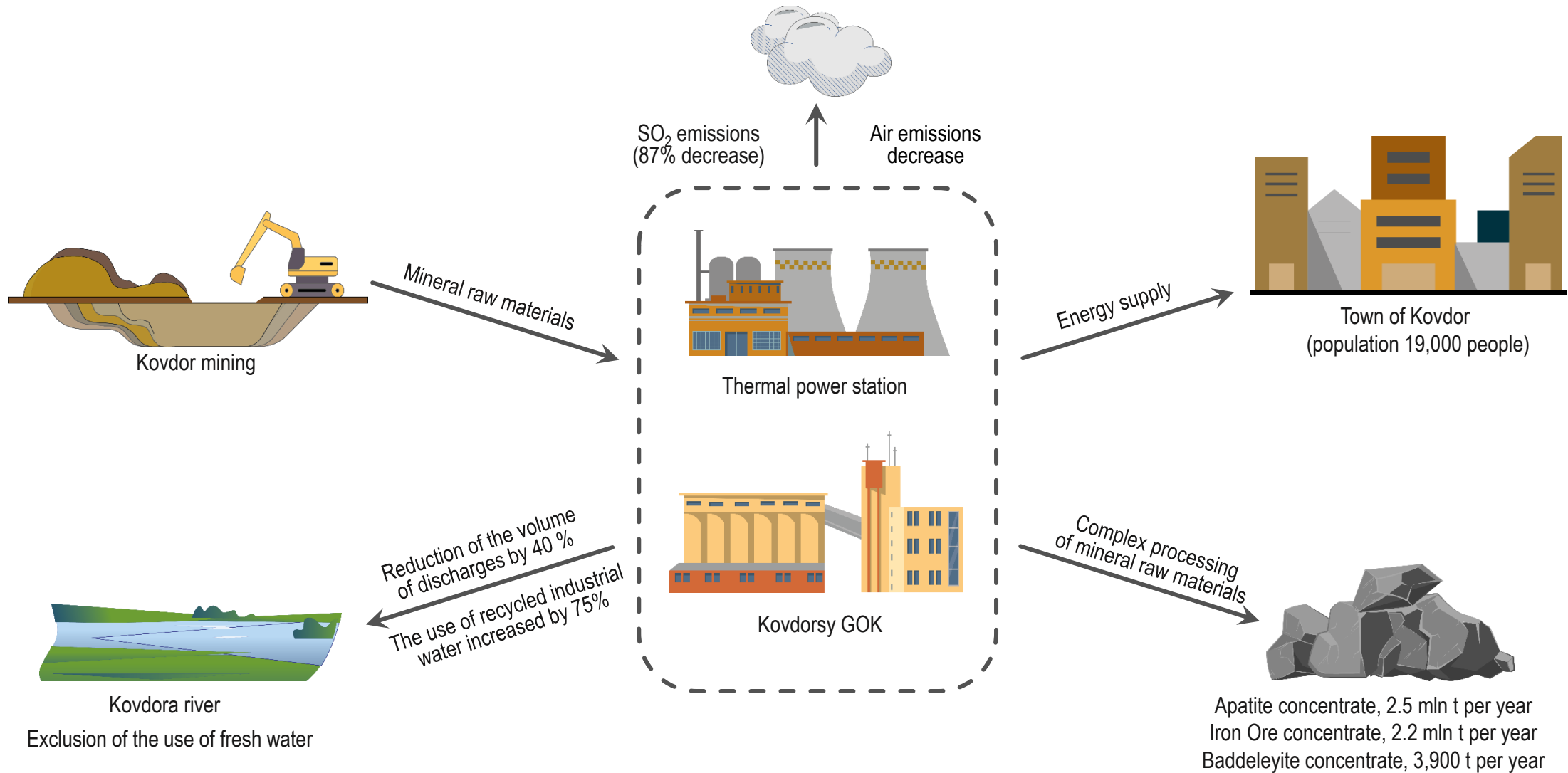


Kovdorskiy GOK: prior to developing Resource Efficiency and Environmental Performance Enhancement Programmes



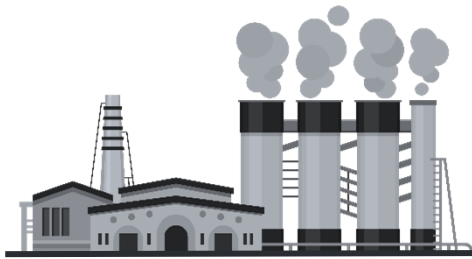

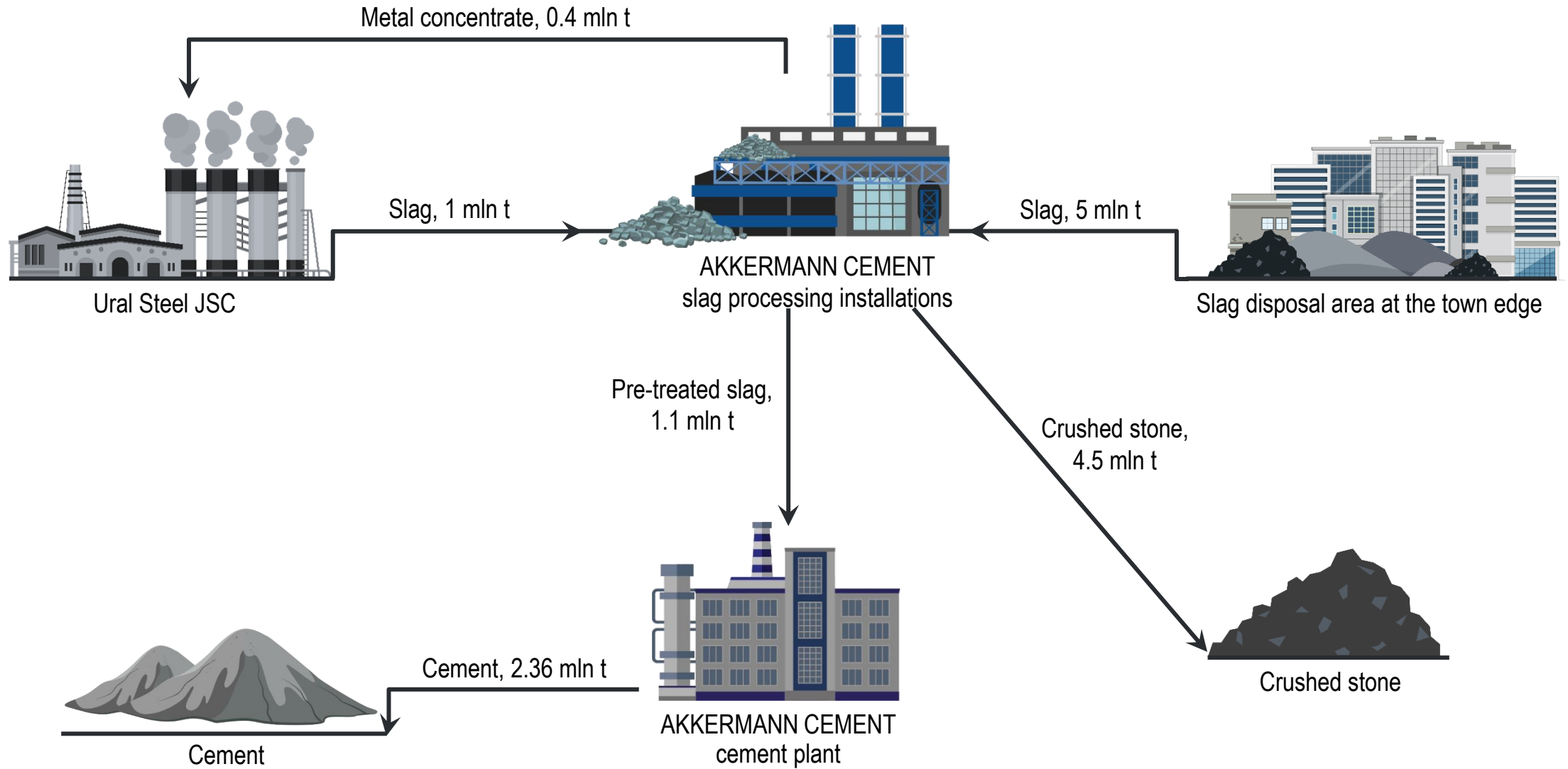
Orsko-Khalilovsky Metallurgical Combine



Slag dumps (accumulated waste)

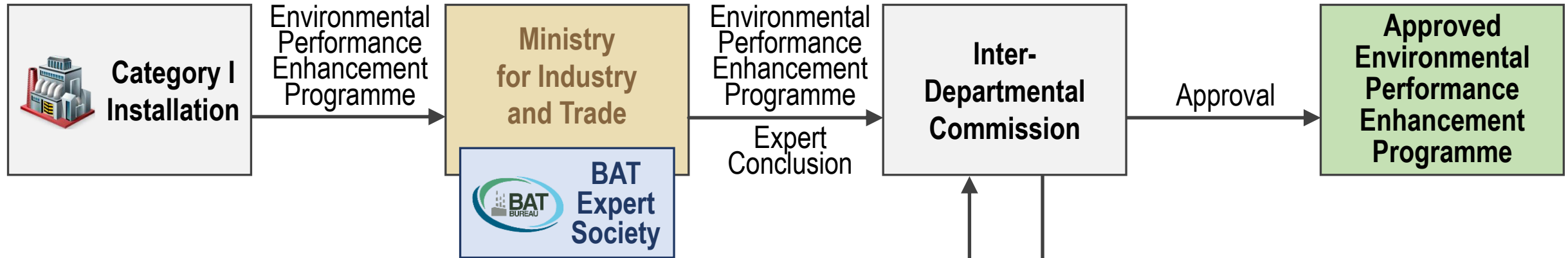

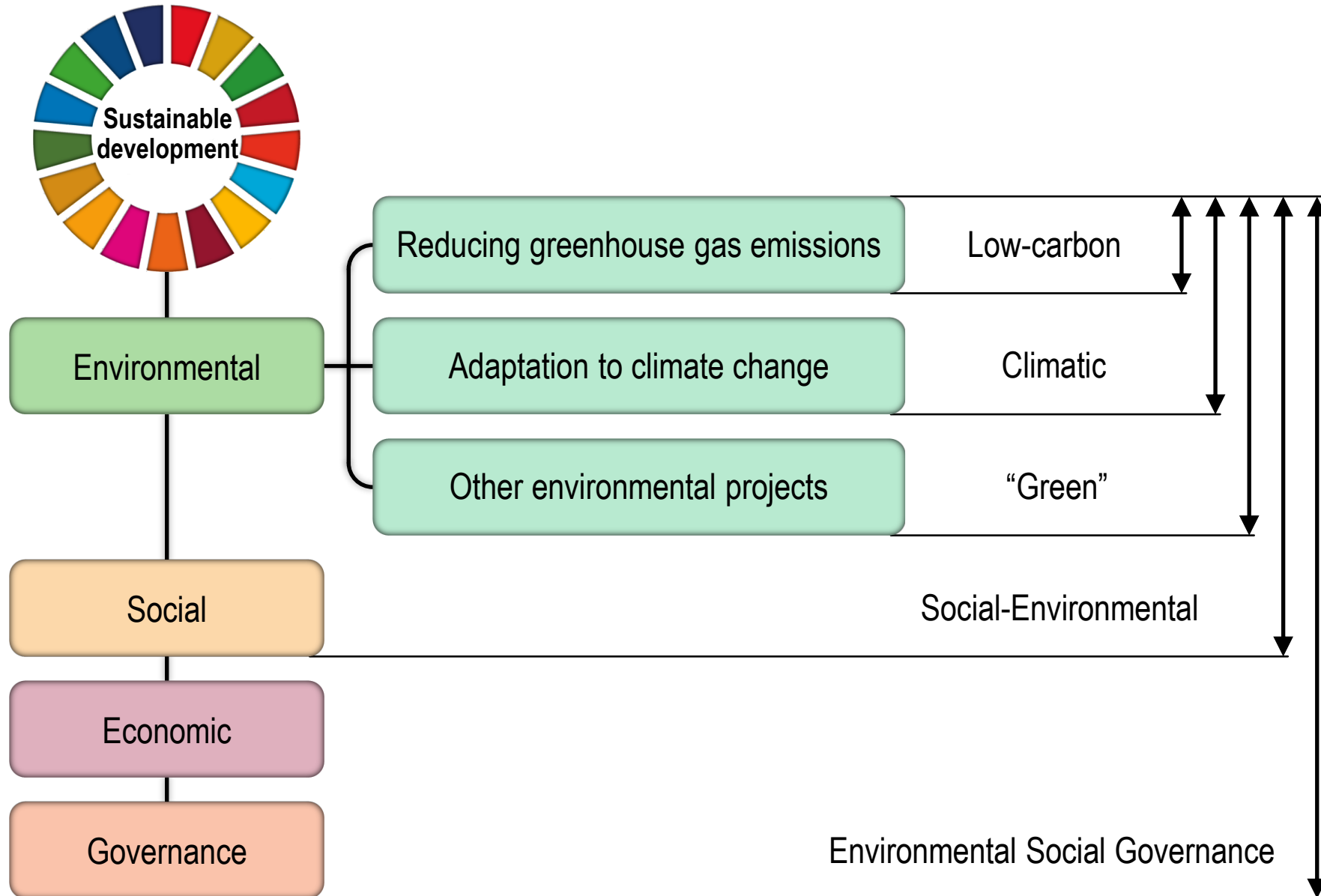
